

Learn How to Catch Walleye at Free Seminar

Salt Lake City -- You can learn how to catch walleye from some of the best walleye anglers in the West.

On March 29, Rocky Mountain Anglers and the Division of Wildlife Resources will present the 19th Annual Utah Walleye Seminar.

Schelble says you'll learn about the best times of year to fish for walleye and the best waters in Utah to catch them at. "You'll also receive information about hot lures and techniques," he says, "including how to troll and how to use spinner rigs, jigs, crankbaits and live baits effectively."
