- 2012 Utah Disabled Veterans Fishing Foundation Established as 501 C3(EIN 45-5572635)
- Last year we had 67 vets and 55 boat volunteers with an additional 20 on shore logistics volunteers.
- This year we are expecting to have 100 veterans and 150 volunteers.
- Format
 - Volunteers are recruited to bring their boats up to Strawberry Reservoir and take veterans out for a day of fishing.
 - Fishing is from 07:00 to approximately 12:30
 - Lunch, keynote speakers, and awards from 1:00 until 3:00
 - Date: June 23, 2018
 - Soldier Creek Recreation Area, Strawberry Reservoir
 - Partnered with Salt Lake VA
 - The VA recruits the veterans, all of which are receiving either inpatient or outpatient therapy.
 - Lunch and Awards Ceremony

- Lunch for all the veterans and volunteers from 1:00 until 3:00
- Veterans receive a gift bag with donated fishing equipment such as a fishing rod, bait, hooks, etc.
- Raffle for donated items-only veterans receive a ticket
